28/29 June - Integrating Cognitive Behavioural Therapy and Hypnosis into Our Clinical Work

The two-day workshop will focus on *Cognitive Hypnotherapy*, an evidence-based multimodal treatment that can be applied to a wide range of patients with emotional disorders, including anxiety and depression. It integrates hypnosis, mindfulness and CBT. This provides an effective host theory to assimilate empirically supported treatment techniques derived from various theoretical models of psychotherapy.

Objectives

- (1) Establish theoretical and empirical rationale for integrating hypnosis and mindfulness with CBT
- (2) Present innovative methods for breaking the emotional cycle
- (3) Describe techniques for accessing and restructuring the "wounded self" (source of core beliefs)
- (4) Demonstrate techniques for rewiring dysfunctional neurocircuits
- (5) Enhance psychophysiological coherence (create internal harmony)
- (6) Propose a research design

Dr. Assen Alladin is a recently retired Clinical Psychologist and Adjunct Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry, University of Calgary Medical School, Canada.
